Subject: Prevent Pre-Planned Electoral Malpractices in Sensitive Booths — Bogus Voting by Women Voters, Mass Rigging, and Booth Capturing by the Ruling Congress Party; Partisan and Biased Policing; Thousands of Fake Voter Identity Cards Being Printed at Talabkatta, Tolichowki and Mehdiapatnam and Illegally Distributed; Money Being Circulated by the Ruling Party with the Active Support of Local Police - Request for Immediate Deployment of Women Police Officers and Women Polling Staff in Polling Stations to Verify Women Voters' Identity, Along with Paramilitary Forces and CCTV Surveillance in Sensitive Booths of the 61-Jubilee Hills Assembly Constituency Bye-Election, 2025 – Reg.

Respected Sir,

We, the representatives of the **Bharat Rashtra Samithi (BRS)**, submit this urgent representation to bring to your notice the alarming deterioration of law and order and the deliberate misuse of police machinery by the ruling **Congress Government** during the ongoing **61-Jubilee Hills Assembly Bye-Election, 2025**.

There is a systematic misuse of the police machinery in the 61-Jubilee Hills Assembly Constituency. The local police, including the Task Force, have colluded with ruling party leaders, indulging in criminal intimidation, illegal detentions, assaulting, and open threats against BRS party workers and sympathisers. Their actions have restrained the democratic right to a peaceful and lawful election campaign, while brazenly facilitating and protecting the gross violations committed by the ruling Congress Party.

Shockingly, the police authorities have even permitted massive public celebrations and inducement activities under the pretext of the Chief Minister's birthday in Yerragadda Division, in clear violation of the Model Code of Conduct. The situation on the ground reflects a complete breakdown of law and order and a deliberate subversion of democratic norms, while the Election Commission and senior police officers remain mute spectators, effectively enabling the ruling Congress Party's misuse of state machinery for electoral gains.



Conspiracy of Organized Electoral Malpractices

We have credible evidence that the ruling Congress Party is executing a **pre-planned rigging, booth capturing, bogus voting conspiracy** involving:

- **Massive influx of bogus voters** from outside the constituency;
- **Bulk booking of function halls and community halls** across Shaikpet, Rahmath Nagar, Yousufguda, Erragadda, and Borabanda to shelter such voters;
- **Distribution of fake voter ID cards** in coordination with local operatives;
- **Planned booth capturing and rigging** on polling day (**11 November 2025**);
- **Police protection to Congress agents** while BRS cadre are detained or harassed.

Sensitive and Vulnerable Booths Identified

Based on our field intelligence and prior incidents, the following areas are **extremely sensitive and vulnerable** to rigging, intimidation, booth capturing and bogus voting:

(a) Shaikpet Division

Gulshan Colony, Mini Gulshan Colony, Diamond Hills. Hakimshah, Virat Nagar, Fathima Nagar, Dollar Hills Colony,, Kohesar Colony, Sabza Colony, Brindavan Colony, Mini Brindavan Colony, Janaki Nagar, Paramount Colony, , IAS Colony
Polling Booth NOs: 20, 21, 22, 40, 41, 42, 54, 55, 56, 57, 58, 61, 62, 63, 64, 65, 66, 67 68, 69, 70

(b) Yerragadda, RahamathNagar, Borabanda, and Yousufguda Divisions: 99% of polling booths in these divisions are **highly vulnerable and sensitive**. It has been observed that the **local police and Task Force personnel, in collusion with ruling party leaders and certain state ministers, are openly indulging in acts of intimidation, threats, and illegal detention** of BRS workers and sympathisers.

Further, credible information indicates a **well-orchestrated conspiracy** to carry out **large-scale bogus voting** by deploying **fake women voters and anti-social elements** on the day of polling, with the **active assistance and protection of the local police**. These actions constitute a **serious breach of the Model Code of Conduct** and pose a **grave threat to the integrity and fairness of the electoral process** in the 61–Jubilee Hills Assembly Constituency.

Illegal camping and intimidation tactics of Non Local AIMIM Leaders

There have been **credible reports and direct observations** of **illegal camping and manipulative tactics** being employed in several of the above-mentioned sensitive areas. The individuals and groups allegedly involved include:

- **Shri Kousar Moinuddin, MLA, Karwan (AIMIM)**
- **Shri Yasar Arafat, Senior Leader, Goshamahal, AIMIM**
- **Shri Rahamath Baig, MLC, Karwan, AIMIM**
- **Shri Rasheed Faraz, Corporator, Shaikpet Division**
- **Shri Ponguleti Srinivas Reddy, State Cabinet Minister**
- **Jupally Krishna Rao, State Cabinet Minister**
- **MLAs and Corporators of AIMIM**

These individuals have reportedly been mobilising persons from outside the Jubilee hills constituency to impersonate genuine **WOMEN VOTERS** and participate in organised bogus voting operations. They have also been influencing local law enforcement authorities, while intimidating polling staff and BRS agents through unauthorised gatherings, inducements, and coercive tactics across Shaikpet, Yerragadda, and Rahamath Nagar segments of the 61–Jubilee Hills Assembly Constituency.

In view of these serious violations and the imminent threat to the conduct of free, fair, and peaceful elections, it is earnestly requested that the aforementioned individuals be strictly restrained from entering or operating within the 61–Jubilee Hills Assembly Constituency after the conclusion of the campaign period, i.e., post 9th November 2025. It is further requested that appropriate preventive and legal measures be immediately initiated to safeguard the integrity of the electoral process.

Our Demands

In view of the above grave violations and imminent threats to electoral integrity, we respectfully urge the Election Commission of India to:

1. **Bind-over known troublemakers** and restrict non-voters and outsiders mentioned above including **Shri Kousar Moinuddin, MLA, Karwan (AIMIM), Shri Yasar Arafat, Senior Leader, Goshamahal, AIMIM, Rahamath Baig, MLC, Karwan, AIMIM, Shri Rasheed Faraz, Corporator, Shaikpet Division, Shri Jupally Krishna Rao and Shri Poguleti Srinivas Reddy, State Cabinet Ministers** from remaining in the Jubileehills constituency after 9th November, 2025 and also during polling period and deploy shadow policemen to monitor and follow their illegal activities violating MCC.
2. **Identify and seize all fake voter identity cards** that are allegedly being illegally printed and circulated by the ruling party, and ensure that such fraudulent ID Cards are strictly prevented from being used during polling for bogus voting.

3. Prevent the Money that is being Circulated to allure the Voters by the Ruling Party leaders with the Active Support of Local Police and Govt Machinery
4. Deploy Central Armed Police Forces (CAPF) immediately in all booths of Shaikpet, RahmathNagar, and Yerragadda, Borabanda, Yousufguda Divisions to ensure neutrality and security.
5. Install CCTV cameras and enable live webcasting from every polling booth within these divisions, with real-time monitoring by ECI-appointed central observers.
6. Declare the above divisions as "Highly Sensitive Booths" and take advance preventive measures.
7. Appoint Special Central Observers for Shaikpet, RahmathNagar, and Yerragadda, Borabanda, Yousufguda Divisions to directly report to the Commission.
8. Prohibit further booking of function halls and community halls until verification, and cancel bogus bookings identified.
9. Appoint WOMEN POLICE OFFICERS in every booth to 100% verify the identity and assist women voters.

The ongoing police bias, inaction of election commission officials, intimidation of BRS leaders by ruling party, and systematic rigging and bogus voting plans by the ruling Congress Party threaten to destroy public faith in democracy and fair and free elections in Telangana.

We urge the Election Commission of India to act swiftly and decisively to preserve the constitutional guarantee of free and fair elections under Article 324 of the Constitution of India.
