Shri Rahul Gandhi Ji...

Is yours actually a national party? Or have you signed away your Congress party as a private franchise to Revanth Reddy in Telangana, giving him a free hand to run his own kingdom as he pleases?

Do you even have a unified national policy regarding the central government's newly imposed "Ji Ram Ji" (VB-G RAM G) scheme? The Government of India, not only repealed the name of Father of Our Nation, Shri Mahatma Gandhi Ji, they have attempted to destroy the very architecture of the policy.

While your All India Congress Committee (AICC) holds a high-decibel press conference in Delhi aggressively condemning this central bill, your own Congress Chief Minister in Telangana quietly passes it through his state cabinet! **The people of Telangana are absolutely shell-shocked by this blatant hypocrisy, your words in Delhi stand in total contradiction to your party's actions in Hyderabad!**

You travel across the length and breadth of this country delivering grand speeches about safeguarding democracy, constitutional values, federalism, and delivering 'Nyay' (social justice) to the marginalized. **Yet, right under your nose in a state ruled by the Congress party, a parallel "private franchise regime" is operating under the guidance and directives of Prime Minister Narendra Modi. Are you genuinely blind to this ideological betrayal, or are you simply pretending not to notice?** Ultimately your social and political credibility is at stake

This duplicity is not just restricted to the "Ji Ram Ji" issue. On multiple fronts, what the Congress party preaches in Delhi is poles apart from what the Revanth Reddy government practices in Hyderabad. **At the national level, you claim to stand firmly against bulldozer governance, the stifling of freedom of speech, corruption, and crony capitalism.** Yet, in Hyderabad, you give the Congress government absolute freedom to behave completely contrary to those principles. Is this not an outright betrayal and deception of the public?

When the historic Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Act (MGNREGA) was originally brought by the Congress-led UPA government, BRS Chief KCR Garu extended unconditional support on the floor of Parliament.

But today, when the Modi regime is systematically dismantling the soul of that very scheme, and your national leadership is opposing it, your Telangana Congress Chief Minister chooses to destroy it, prostrating himself before the Modi Ji's government.

I. The Blatant Contradiction: AICC National Stand vs. Revanth Reddy's Surrender:

On July 1, 2026, from the AICC Headquarters at 24 Akbar Road in Delhi, your party's Communication Department and the Parliamentary Standing Committee Chairman, Shri Saptagiri Ulaka, held an official press briefing. The AICC forcefully condemned the anti-poor "VB-G RAM G" (Ji Ram Ji) framework introduced by the Modi government.

Your party explicitly stated that "Ji Ram Ji" is not meant to strengthen rural employment, but to execute its cold-blooded murder. While the national Congress party vows to fight this black law from Parliament to the streets, the Revanth Reddy government in Telangana chose the path of absolute cowardice. Without an iota of resistance, they hastily approved this exact anti-poor law in a state cabinet meeting on July 2, 2026.

This is not just a direct violation of your party's national stance; it is definitive proof of a covert, under-the-table deal between Revanth Reddy and the BJP leadership.

II. Resistance by Other States – Telangana's Total Surrender

While your government in Telangana has knelt before Delhi, several other states across India are fighting back fiercely to protect the spirit of federalism:

- **Karnataka:** Your neighboring Congress-ruled state of Karnataka initially rejected this policy in its cabinet and has gone a step further by knocking on the doors of the Supreme Court.
- **Punjab:** The Punjab State Assembly passed a unanimous resolution outrightly rejecting this central encroachment.
- **Tamil Nadu, Bihar, and Jharkhand:** Tamil Nadu Chief Minister C. Joseph Vijay wrote a stinging letter to the Prime Minister stating that this policy inflicts an unbearable additional burden of over ₹5,000 crores on the state budget. **States like Bihar, Madhya Pradesh, and Jharkhand** have demanded an immediate review of its flawed funding structure.

When multiple states are putting up a historic fight to protect constitutional federalism, the Telangana Cabinet and its Sub-Committee chose to surrender meekly to the dictates of the Modi Ji's Government.

This makes it undeniably clear: Telangana is not being governed by the welfare ideology of Rahul Gandhi, but by a private franchise of Revanth Reddy operating purely on Modi's principles.

III. Shri Rahul Gandhi Garu, Why This Utter Weakness?

On behalf of the Bharat Rashtra Samithi (BRS) and the people of Telangana, we demand direct answers to these burning questions:

1. **Why are you tolerating this absolute indiscipline?** When the AICC officially tears down a central policy in Delhi, how can your own Chief Minister validate and adopt it in a state cabinet meeting? Is this not the ultimate peak of internal indiscipline within the Congress party?
2. **What is the secret weakness behind your silence?** Why are you a silent spectator while Revanth Reddy tramples upon national Congress values to implement the BJP's agenda? What hold does he have over your high command?
3. **What happened to the grand promises in your "Nyay Patra"?** In your 2023 assembly manifesto and 2024 national manifesto, you promised to increase the MGNREGA daily wage to ₹400. Yet, in your own backyard of Telangana, MGNREGA Field Assistants and rural laborers have been denied their basic wages for the past three months (since March), pushing thousands of families to the brink of starvation.
When you cannot implement your promises in a state you rule, why should the nation believe a single word of your manifestos? How can anyone have faith in your core ideology?

IV. Our Immediate Charter of Demands

On behalf of the lakhs of rural laborers and the Field Assistants who have served for over 20 years, the BRS party places the following non-negotiable demands and **we urge you prevail upon your self-proclaimed Hitler CM Shri Revanth Reddy and ensure the implementation:**

1. **Revoke State Cabinet Approval for "Ji Ram Ji":** In line with the AICC's national stance, the Telangana government must immediately rescind its cabinet approval, reject the Delhi dictate, and move the Supreme Court to fight for federal rights.
2. **Release Pending Salaries Instantly:** Clear the three months of pending wages due to Field Assistants since March, complete with interest.
3. **Execute the 2023 Assembly Manifesto:** Fulfill the written state election promise to provide absolute job security and a formal pay scale to all Field Assistants.

4. **Convert Workers to FTE Mode:** Convert the Field Assistants into Full-Time Employees (F.T.E.) and fix a monthly minimum wage of ₹25,000.
5. Implement the ₹400 Daily Wage: Match the 2024 national manifesto commitment by raising the daily wage to ₹400 and expanding guaranteed work to 150 days per year.
6. **Revoke Circular 4779:** Unconditionally reinstate all terminated Field Assistants under List 3, provide health cards to all, and grant a ₹10 lakh ex-gratia to the families of deceased workers.

V. Conclusion

Trampling upon your own 2023 and 2024 manifestos and subordinating the state to a script written by Modi and Amit Shah is nothing short of a democratic betrayal.

The BRS party vehemently condemns this duplicitous stand of the Telangana Congress and its double standards.

If you truly stand with the rural poor, and if you truly believe and practice respect for your own stated ideology, **you must immediately confront your Chief Minister Revanth Reddy and force his cabinet to withdraw its support for this anti-poor "Ji Ram Ji" policy.**

If your state government fails to act immediately, the BRS party will mobilize the entire rural workforce to launch an aggressive, unrelenting agitation from the village level to the State Secretariat. **Furthermore, we will take this fight directly to New Delhi and expose your double standards on the national stage, unmasking how Indian congress party stage a fake "wrestling match" with the BJP in Delhi, while Revanth Congress entering into a cozy, corrupt "friendship" in Telangana!**
